- 1) Length : Happy with your natural nail length ? --> Gel overlay or manicure with polish will do. Polish costs less but it does not last as long as gel . If you want some simple one color or french, there is a polish like gel product such as "Shellac" in the market, too.
- 2) Shape : I often recommend oval for brides as it makes more feminine style of nails. However, if your nails are relatively wide , flat or short, stick to square shape may be a choice. Some designs look better on either shape so ask your nail tech !
- 3) Designs: Wanna simple nails or gorgeous nails with 3D and stones ? What about your budget ? You can always tell your nail tech your budget , styles you prefer. Or you can send me an e-mail (km@glamnailstudio.com) or just call the salon for consultation.
